**Direction issued by the Commission**

These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 10.10.2011. In response, a letter dated 20.10.2011 has been received from Dy. Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi addressed to Under Secretary, Home (Special Department), Government of Bihar, Patna with a copy to the Commission. A request has been made to Under Secretary that opinion regarding enhancement of monetary relief to the next of kin of the deceased along with MLCs of the six injured persons be sent to the NHRC at the earliest under intimation to the Ministry of Home Affairs. The Commission has also received a letter dated 15.11.2011 from Joint Secretary, Government of Bihar, Home (Special Department) addressed to District Magistrate, Araria with a copy to the Commission. A request has been made to ask for the sanction of requisite budget for payment to the next of kin of the deceased and six injured from Under Secretary, Home (Special Department), Government of Bihar, Patna. The Commission has considered the reports. Despite sufficient time and opportunity having been given, the proof of payment of Re. 1 lac each made to the next of kin of the deceased and MLCs of six injured have not been received by the Commission. In these circumstances, let summons be issued for the personal appearance of Chief Secretary, Government of Bihar, Patna before the Commission on 20/1/2012 at 11.00 A.M. along with the aforesaid reports. In case the said reports are received on or before 13/1/2012, the personal appearance of Chief Secretary, Government of Bihar, Patna shall stand dispensed with.
