

■ **Rights group flays UN**

HUMAN RIGHTS watchdog, the Asian Centre for Human Rights (ACHR), regretted the United Nations' failure to appoint a special rapporteur on Nepal.

The ACHR said this was a result of the failure to sponsor a country resolution on Nepal in the ongoing 61st session of the Commission on Human Rights in Geneva.

The rights group blamed the "ambivalent attitude" of India, the US and the UK for it, adding "it is a failure of the international community to make its statement of disapproval against the coup".
