With reference to your complaint dated 15/03/2012, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 24/04/2017. The Commission has made the following directions.

*Vide its proceedings dated 30.06.2016, the Commission recommended to the Government of Madhya Pradesh for payment of a sum of Rs. 5.00 lakhs to the next of kin of the deceased Ajay Mishra within six weeks. Chief Secretary, Government of Madhya Pradesh was required to submit compliance report along with proof of payment within two weeks thereafter.*

*Pursuant to the directions of the Commission, Under Secretary to the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh vide communication dated 03.04.2017 has forwarded a copy of the receipt regarding payment of Rs 5 lakhs to the next of kin of the deceased Ajay Mishra.*

*In view of compliance of the recommendation of the commission the case is closed.*

Direction issued by the Commission	These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the Commission's earlier proceedings dated 20.09.2013. The Additional Secretary to the Government of M.P., Home Department has intimated that a case crime No.93/13 u/s 304, 323, 34 IPC has been registered against S.I., Ramesh Chand Arya, Constables, Ashok Kumar and Surender Singh. No reply to the notice u/s 18 of the Protection of Human Rights Act has been received. Issue a reminder to the Chief Secretary, Government of M.P. to send within eight weeks a reply to the show cause notice why the Commission should not recommend relief for the next of kin of the late Ajay Mishra, failing which it shall assume that the Government of M.P. has no views on the matter and would make appropriate recommendations on the basis of material available on record. He is also expected to send within eight weeks the CBCID enquiry report and a report on departmental proceedings against the erring officials in the light of the findings of the magisterial enquiry
