| Direction issued by the Commission | Finding prima facie that Amol Raghunath Kuchekar died as a result of the multiple injuries sustained in police custody, the Commission by its proceedings dated 9th February, 2012 issued notice u/s 18 of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993 to the Government of Maharashtra to show cause as to why a monetary relief of Rs. five lakhs be not recommended to be paid to the next of kin of deceased Amol Raghunath Kuchekar. In response, Joint Secretary, Home Department, Govt. of Maharashtra vide his communication dated 13th June, 2012 had informed that the show cause notice issued by the Commission is under consideration of the Government and necessary approvals are being taken to pay the compensation. Therefore, he sought extension of three months' time to comply with the recommendations of the Commission. In spite of a lapse of over one year, the State Government has not responded to the notice. As a last opportunity, a final reminder be issued to Chief Secretary, Govt. of Maharashtra to submit response to the show cause notice within six weeks, failing which we may proceed on the assumption that the State Government has nothing to say against the grant of monetary relief. Put up after six weeks. |
