Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 01-Dec-10 and the Commission has directed as follows.

Shri Jarupula Srinu of village Jarupula Thanda in District Warangal, Andhra Pradesh, died in police custody after consuming Endosulfan. The Commission found during the inquiry that the deceased could consume the insecticide due to negligence of Home Guard of police station Maripeda, in whose custody he was at the relevant time. Hence, through its proceedings dated 01.05.2008, the Commission ordered issuance of a show cause notice U/S 18 (a) (i) of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993, to the State of Andhra Pradesh, through its Chief Secretary.

The show cause notice has been responded to by the Collector and District Magistrate, Warangal, through his letter dated 04.12.2009. As per this letter, the government has disbursed an amount of Rs.20,000/- to the wife of the deceased. Proof of payment is annexed to the letter.

The Commission feels that compensation of Rs.20,000/- is too meager for the death of a person due to negligence of a public servant. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the Commission recommends to the Government of Andhra Pradesh, through its Chief Secretary, to pay additional sum of Rs 80000 (Rupees Eighty Thousand) to the widow of the deceased Shri Jarupula Srinu. The Chief Secretary of the State is directed to submit the compliance report alongwith proof of payment within six weeks.

It is therefore, requested that the compliance report in the matter be sent to the Commission latest by 19-Jan-11, so that the same could be placed before the Commission.
