With reference to your complaint dated 21/02/2011, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 21/09/2015. The Commission has made the following directions.

These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 30,3,2015 vide which the Commission held that a clear case of violation of human rights is made out and the State is liable for payment of monetary compensation to the next of kin of the deceased, Javed.

The Commission recommended to the Government of Uttar Pradesh through its Chief Secretary to pay compensation of Rs. 2,00,000/- to the next of kin of the deceased. The Chief Secretary, Government of Uttar Pradesh was directed to submit compliance report along with proof of payment within eight weeks.

The Commission has received a response from the Senior Superintendent, District Jail, Ajamgarh intimating that a sum of Rs. 2,00,000/- have been paid to Smt. Saima Bano, wife of the deceased, by transferring the amount in her bank account No. 466002120000486 through e-payment. A copy of the certificate of e-payment of the State Bank of India is also enclosed.

Since the recommendations of the Commission have been complied with and the proof of payment has been submitted, the case now stands closed.
