Direction issued by the Commission	The Commission received an intimation from Supdt. of Police, Azarngarh, regarding suicidal death of Kamlesh Kumar Singh in police custody. It was reported that a murder case was registered at PS Gambhirpur on 6th April, 2011. During investigation of the case, the name of Kamlesh Kumar Singh came to light. He was arrested on 14th April, 2011. On 15th April, 2011 he committed suicide in the toilet of the police lock up by hanging himself with shirt and pant from the lamp post at about 8.03 AM. The postmortem report revealed the following injuries: i) Ante-mortem abraded area of neck anterialy. Two abrasions on the right side of the neck and two on the left side. ii) Small bruises on anterior part of the neck. iii) Neck muscle bruised on right side. According to the postmortem surgeon, the death had occurred due to pressure on neck and Ihoracic cage resulting in asphysic and shock. An inquiry into the circumstances of death was conducted by Judicial Magistrate, Court No. 15, Azarngah. The Magistrate did not believe the story of suicide. Dr. Vimlesh Kumar, who conducted the postmortem was examined by the Magistrate. He deposed that the postmortem started at 3.10 PM on 15th April, 2011 and the Rigor Mortis had fully developed. He stated that It takes at least 12 hours for full development of Rigor Mortis. In other words at least 12 hours had elapsed after the death. This would mean that the dead had occurred between 3.00 AM and 4.00 AM and not at 8.00 AM as alleged by the police. The Magistrate also noted that pressure marks and not ligature mark were observed on the neck. The pressure marks were parallel and not oblique. Considering all these observations made by the postmortem surgeon, the Magistrate concluded that it was a case of homicidal death. On consideration of the Magisterial Enquiry Report and postmortem report, we are not inclined to believe that Kamlesh Kumar Singh hanged himself in the police lock up. It appears to be a case of homicidal death. A notice, therefore, be issued under Section 18 of the Pro
