With reference to your complaint dated 05/12/2011, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 01/10/2014. The Commission has made the following directions.

These proceedings shall be read in continuation of earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 6.6.2014.

In response the Chief Secretary, Government of Mizoram vide his communication dated 14.8.2014 has submitted the compliance report. Perusal of the same reveals that an amount of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) as recommended by the Commission has been paid on 29.7.2014 to the victim P.U. Lobindro Chakma. Proof of payment has also been annexed. Proof of payment has also been annexed. The amount is to be recouped from the salary of PU John Tanpula the then B.D.O., Lungsen.

The Commission has considered the matter. The amount of Interim Relief as recommended by the Commission has been paid to victim. The Chief Secretary, Government of Mizoram shall however ensure that the Departmental proceedings initiated against the delinquent officer PU John Tanpuia are concluded expeditiously. With these directions, the reports received from the State Authorities are taken on record and the case is closed.

Let a copy of these proceedings be also transmitted to Information Officer, NHRC and to beneficiary.

I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 06/06/2014 and the Commission has directed as follows.

This proceeding shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 28.11.2013.

Pursuant to the show cause notice issued by the Commission, a report dated 5.2,2014 has been received from the Dy. Secretary, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms, Government of Mizoram which shows that disciplinary proceedings have been initiated against the erring officer Shri John Tanputa, Member of Mizoram Civil Services for use of alleged force against Shri Lobindro Chakma.

No reason/explanation has been furnished by the Chief Secretary or even by the Dy. Secretary against the proposed action for payment of compensation to the victim.

As the enquiry conducted by AddL DCP clearly established that the victim Lobindro Chakma S/o Chitra Kumar Chakma was forcibly taken by the BDO and his subordinate from Sihphirtlang to Lungsen and he was also threatened thereby violating his human rights to life, liberty and dignity. The Commission recommends u/s 18 (a) (i) of the PHR Act, 1993 to the State Government of Mizoram through its Chief Secretary to pay a sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) as monetary relief/compensation to the victim Lobindro Chakma at an early date. A report along with proof of payment be sent within six weeks.

It is therefore, requested that the compliance report in the matter be sent to the Commission latest by 30/07/2014, so that the same could be placed before the Commission.
