With reference to your complaint dated 01/04/2011, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 21/06/2012. The Commission has made the following directions.

These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 19th April, 2012.

In response, the Deputy Commissioner, Khunti vide his communication dated 5th May, 2012 has submitted the compliance report. Perusal of the same reveals that an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) as recommended by the Commission has been paid to Smt. Neli Tigga, the wife of the deceased Mansidh Tigga vide a banker's cheque No.907626 dated 31st March, 2012. The proof of payment has also been annexed.


The Commission has considered the matter. The amount of interim relief as recommended by the Commission has been paid to the next of kin of the deceased. No further action is called for. The compliance report is taken on record and the case is closed.

Direction issued by the Commission	These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 14.11.2011. In response, the Deputy Secretary, Home Department, Government of Jharkhand vide his communication dated 15th December, 2011 has stated that the State Government has no objection in grant of token monetary relief to the next of kin of the deceased. The Commission has considered the matter. The State Government has no objection in grant of interim relief to the next of kin of the deceased. An amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) is recommended to be paid as interim relief to the next of kin of the deceased. Chief Secretary, Government of Jharkhand, Ranchi, is directed to send the proof of payment made to the next of kin of the deceased Mansidh Tigga. Response in four weeks.
