Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 06/03/2009, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 18/08/2015. The Commission has made the following directions.

In the judgment of the High Court of Manipur at Imphal in Writ Petition (Criminal) No. 49 of 2009, direction was given to the Respondents to pay a sum of Rs. five lakhs to the petitioner Mst. Garamjan Bibi, mother of the deceased Md. Azad Khan. The High Court held that the Manipur Police Commandos and the Assam Rifle personnel were responsible for the death of the petitioner's son and hence, they would be liable for payment of compensation under the public law remedy as the death was caused without following the process established by law. The High Court, however, did not fix any criminal liability or directed prosecution of any of the persons responsible for the death of the petitioner's son. In such circumstances, the Commission does not find it necessary to pursue this case any further. The case is, therefore, closed.
