Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 02/09/2013, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 18/06/2016. The Commission has made the following directions.

1. A minor tribal girl was allegedly gangraped by 7 college students on 27.8.2013 near the Bundo Bus Stand, in the jurisdiction of PS Bundo, District Ranchi, Jharkhand. Through his complaint dated 2.9.2013, Shri Amal Kanti Chakma, Complaints Coordinator of the NGO, "Asian Centre for Human Rights" sought Commission's intervention in the matter.

2. During the inquiry by the Commission, report dated 8.5.2014 was received from the SSP, Ranchi, which said that crime No. 91/2013 w/s 363/364/34 IPC was registered at PS Bundo on 28.8.2013 against 7 unknown culprits. During the investigation of the case, the 7 accused were identified and arrested on 29.8.2013 and a chargesheet dated 30.9.2013 w/s 363/364/376(2)(i)/376D/34 IPC and section 3(1)(xi)(xii) of the SC/ST (PoA) Act was filed in the Court.

3. On a query raised by the Commission, the Dy. Commissioner of Ranchi, informed the Commission vide his communication dated 12.8.2014 that the victim had been paid statutory compensation of Rs. 25,000/- under the SC/ST (PoA) Act. This report of the Dy. Commissioner was considered by the Commission in its proceedings of 6.9.2013 and the Commission found that the compensation had not been paid as provided under the relevant Entries No. 11 and 12 in Annexure I of the Schedule of the SC/ST (PoA) Rules, 1995. The Commission drew the attention of the Dy. Commissioner, Ranchi, to these Entries and directed him to submit further report on the subject. Now, 50% of the total compensation of Rs. 1,20,000/-, payable after the medical examination of the victim, has been paid to the victim. Payment receipts for Rs. 25,000/- and Rs. 35,000/- (total Rs. 60,000/-) executed by the victim are enclosed with the report dated 20.4.2016 of the SSP, Ranchi.

4. A chargesheet having already been filed in the court, and the required compensation under the SC/ST (PoA) Rules, 1995, having also been paid to the victim, no further intervention of the Commission in the matter is required and the case is closed.
