With reference to your complaint dated 15/07/2011, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 15/03/2013. The Commission has made the following directions.

These proceedings shall be read in continuation to the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 11.2.2013.

In response, Special Secretary, Home Department, Government of West Bengal, vide his communication dated 13.2.2013, has submitted the Compliance Report. Perusal of the same reveals that an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only), as recommended by the Commission, has been paid to Smt. Mampi Debnath (Pandit), wife of the deceased on 21.1.2013. The proof of payment has also been annexed.

The Commission has considered the matter. The amount of interim relief, us recommended by the Commission, has been paid to the next of kin of the deceased. No further action is called for. The reports received from the State authorities are taken on record and the case is closed.
