Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 04/08/2010, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 06/07/2012. The Commission has made the following directions.

The Commission vide its proceedings dated 09.02.2012 had recommended to the Chief Secretary, Government of Karantaka to pay a sum of Rs.20,000/- to Shri H.G. Prakyath as compensation. It also directed the Director General and Inspector General of Police, Bangalore to submit the status of disciplinary proceedings initiated against the delinquent police officers.

In response to the aforesaid directions, a communication dated 24.05.2012 has been received from the Office of Director General and Inspector General of Police, informing the Commission that a sum of Rs.20,000/- has been paid to Shri H.G. Prakyath through Cheque No. CF322277 dated 07.05.2012. The Proof of payment has also been submitted. However, the status of disciplinary proceedings against the concerned delinquent police officers is still awaited.

The Commission has considered the matter. Since the recommendation regarding payment of compensation has been complied with, the case is closed. As regards disciplinary proceedings, the Commission expects the DG&IG of Police to conclude the same at the earliest and take appropriate further action.

A copy of these proceedings should be sent to the recipient of the relief, to the complainant and to the I.O.
