A communication dated 30.1.2014 has been received from Superintendent, Home-III, Chandigarh Administration informing that as per the directions of the Commission, the monetary relief of Rs. one lakh by means of a demand draft was sent through Tehsildar, U.T., Chandigarh for handing over the same to Shri Sanyasi, father of the deceased Raja at his address i.e. D 1st, 231, Madangir, New Delhi. However, the demand draft could not be handed over to the beneficiary as he is not residing at the above address. On perusal of the judicial inquiry report dated 28.7.2009 conducted by Ms. Amandeep Kaur, PCS, Judicial Magistrate First Class into the incident, it is seen that Smt. Santosh, wife of deceased Raja appeared before the Magistrate and recorded her statement and that the address of the deceased recorded in the judicial inquiry report is H.No. H-1, 231, Madangir, New Delhi. The Secretary, Home, Chandigarh Administration may be requested to clarify within six weeks why sanction was granted for making payment of Rs one lakh in favour of Shri Sanyasi, father of deceased when Smt. Santosh, wife of the deceased Raja is alive. The Home Secretary shall also clarify how the demand draft was sought to be delivered to Shri Sanyasi at the address D 1st, 231 Madangir, New Delhi whereas the address of the deceased Raja, S/o Sanyasi is H.No.H-1, 231, Madangir, New Delhi as recorded in the judicial inquiry. Post after six weeks.
