Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 01/08/2011, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 05/09/2013. The Commission has made the following directions.

These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings.

The complainant in his complaint dated 01/8/2011 has alleged rape of a girl by Phurden Lepcha, a constable of Sikkim Police at Bojoghari in East District of Sikkim on 23/7/2011.

Vide proceedings dated 226/4/13, the Commission recommended to the Chief Secretary, Government of Sikkim to make payment of Rupees 3 lakhs as interim relief for the victim Ms. Tshering Yangzom Bhutia, aged 23, daughter of Shri Tenzing Bhutia. The proof of payment was to be submitted within 6 weeks.

In response, the Commission has received a report dated 20/8/13 from the Special Secretary, Home Department, Government of Sikkim that in compliance with the Commission's directions Rs. 3.00/- lakhs vide cheque No. 675005 dated 14/8/13 drawn at State Bank of Sikkim as interim relief has been paid to the victim Tshering Yangzom Bhutia, aged 23, daughter of Shri Tenzing Bhutia and the receipt of the same is enclosed.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, no further intervention by the Commission is required. The case is closed.

A copy of these proceedings should be sent to the IO of the Commission and to the recipient of the relief.
