Proceeding	<p>The complainants A.K. Tripathi, and Tejang Chakma of different NGOs vide their complaints alleged that two minor dalit girls named Kajal, 9 years and Shikha, 10 years died due to electrocution on 11.07.2011 when they came into contact with a snapped live wire while they were going for some work. Complainants have prayed for action against the negligent officials and compensation to the next of kin of the two deceased girls.</p> <p>In response to the notice of the Commission, a report dated 09.03.2012 was received from U.P. Power Corporation Limited. The report revealed that the residents of Harijan Basti had unlawfully taken connection from L.T. line by using an iron wire which suddenly fell down and caused the accident. In this regard, case No.61/11 was registered and a charge-sheet u/s.304A IPC r.w. Sec.135 of Indian Electricity Act was submitted in the Court.</p> <p>The Commission also received a similar report from the Director, Electricity Safety, Government of Uttar Pradesh. The report disclosed that the Junior Engineer and Line Man of the Electricity Department were failed to check pilferage of electricity, due to which the fatal incident occurred. As per the report, the Junior Engineer, Shri Amar Nath and the Line Man Shri Dharamveer Singh had violated provisions of rule 29(1) of Indian Electricity Manual, 1956 and recommended for departmental action and compensation to the victims. The report also stated that the transmission line was not maintained properly. Accordingly, ex-gratia amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- each was paid to the NOK of the deceased. Proof of payment had been annexed.</p> <p>In view of the above, the Commission observed that the amount of compensation already paid in the matter is inadequate and recommended for an additional amount of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rs. Two lankhs only) each as relief to be paid to the NOK of both the deceased. A show-cause notice was issued to the Govt. of Uttar Pradesh.</p> <p>The Principal, Secretary, Department of Energy, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh and the Superintendent of Police, Jounpur, Uttar Pradesh were directed to conduct an Enquiry on inaction and delay on the part of their respective departments in the matter as observed above in the proceedings and shall submit their action taken reports within this period.</p> <p>In response, Deputy General Manager (OC), UP Power Corporation Ltd., Lucknow, vide his letter dated 25.06.,2015 informed that the Junior Engineer Shri Amarnath concerned with the death of two minor Dalit girls, Km. Kajaj, and Km. Shiksha, was retired from service on 31.12.2011 and the Lineman Dharamvir Singh was terminated from service on 06.12.2014. The additional compensation amount of Rs.2,00,000/- each had been paid to the NOK of the deceased girls by cheques dated 22.06.2015. Copies of proof of payment and other documents have been annexed with the communication.</p> <p>A similar report dated 01.08.2015 had been received from Superintendent of Police, Jaunpur. But the report is silent about the departmental action taken against the police officials of PS Jalalpur, Jaunpur for delay in registering the FIR in the case and non-</p>				

inclusion of the aforesaid two indicted persons from the accused array.

The Commission has perused and considered the above reports.

As the recommendations of the Commission have been complied with and proof of payments have been furnished, no further action is necessary and the case is closed.

Direction issued by the Commission	The Special Secretary, Electricity Department, U.P. Government, Lucknow has intimated vide his report dated 5.8.2013 that a sum of Rs. 1 lakh each has been paid through cheques as monetary relief to the next of kin/legal heirs of late Km. Kajal (9 yrs.) daughter of Vinod Kumar and Km. Shikha (10 yrs.) daughter of Uma Shankar. The photocopies of the cheques of Rs. 1 lakh each have been enclosed with the report but receipts for payment of the said amount to the recipients have not been enclosed. The Commission vide its several communications had directed the General Manager, Eastern Electricity Distribution Corporation Ltd. U.P. to submit a copy of the enquiry report of Chief Electrical Engineer, U.P. but the desired report has not yet been submitted which was necessary to ascertain as to how the said electrical accident took place resulting in the death of Km. Kajal and Km. Shikha and how far the officers/officials of the Electricity Corporation were responsible for the accident. Issue a final reminder to the General Manager, Eastern Electricity Distribution Corporation Ltd., Jaunpur, U.P. to send an enquiry report of Chief Electrical Engineer to U.P. Government within six weeks positively failing which the Commission shall be constrained to take action u/s 13 of the PHR Act, 1993. The Special Secretary, Electricity Department, Government of U.P., Lucknow is also directed to send within six weeks the proof of payment/receipt of the amount of Rs. 1 lakh each reported to have been paid to the father of each of the above named deceased.
