With reference to your complaint dated 02/02/2012, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 30/12/2013. The Commission has made the following directions.

These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 30.04.2013.

In response, the District Collector, Jaipur, Rajasthan vide his communication dated 04.06.2013 has submitted the report. Perusal of the same reveals that an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) has been paid to Smt. Aradhana Sapra, wife of the deceased on 01.06.2013. Proof of payment have also been annexed.

The Commission has considered the matter. The amount of interim relief of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) as recommended by the Commission has been paid to next of kin of the deceased. No further action is called for. The reports received from the State Authorities are taken on record and the case is closed.

Let a copy of these proceedings be also transmitted to the I.O., NHRC and to the beneficiary.

In response, the Joint Secretary, Home (Human Rights) Department, Government of Rajasthan, vide his communication dated 2.4.2013, has submitted the report. Perusal of the same reveals that an amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only), as recommended by the Commission, has been sanctioned by the State Government and District Collector, Jaipur, has been directed to furnish the proof of payment made to next of kin of the deceased within 15 days. The proof of payment has, however, not been received. The Commission has considered the matter. Let a Notice be sent to the District Collector, Jaipur, calling upon him to submit the proof of payment made to next of kin of the deceased Yogesh Sapra within four weeks without fail, failing which coercive process will be issued.
