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Sir/Madam.

I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 28/04/2010 and the Commission has directed as follows.

These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 22.2.2010.

In response, a letter dated 1.4.2010 has been received from Director General of Police, Haryana. Perusal of the same reveals that the victim girl Puja is an upper caste Brahmin girl and not a dalit girl. She married a dalit boy as per record of Supdt. of Police, Karnal. Inspector Jai Singh was arrested on 26.6.2008. The challan has been filed in the court. The Inspector has also been dismissed from service. All possible action under law has been taken against Inspector Jai Singh by the police. Since the matter is subjudice, it is not appropriate to make any recommendation for giving compensation at this stage.

The victim Puja used to go to the police station to meet her parents. Taking advantage, Inspector Jai Singh committed rape on her at his official residence on 26.6.2008. The protector of law became perpetrator of crime by committing rape on a hapless girl thus, violating her human rights. In these circumstances, the Commission feels that grant of monetary relief to the victim is justified. An amount of Rs. 5,00,000/-(Rupees Five Lakh only) is recommended to be paid as monetary relief to the victim. Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, Chandigarh is directed to send proof of payment made to the victim to the Commission within eight weeks.

It is therefore, requested that the compliance report in the matter be sent to the Commission latest by 05/07/2010, so that the same could be placed before the Commission.
