Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 14/07/2009, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 16/08/2017. The Commission has made the following directions.

The Commission vide proceedings dated 25th January, 2017, had recommended to the Govt. of Assam to pay a sum of Rs. Five lakhs as monetary relief to the next of kin of two deceased persons namely Krishna Chandra Tripura and Shaining Langril, who died on 10.7.2009 after being shot by the PSO of SP, CID, Assam.

The Joint Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Home & Political Deptment has informed that the amount of Rs. Five Lakhs as recommended by the Commission has been paid to the next of kin of the two deceased persons: The proof of payment has also been received.

Since the recommendation of the Commission has been complied with, the case is closed.
