One Krutibash Mahapatra, aged 25 years died in the custody of Energy Police Station, Cuttuck, Odisha on 1.3.2013 in a mysterious circumstances. The Commission on considering the post mortem report, magisterial enquiry report, viscera examination report and other relevant records in the matter came to the conclusion that the deceased died due to consumption of organophosphorus insecticidal poison while he was in police custody. Therefore, the Commission recommended to the Govt. of Odisha to pay an amount of Rs.One Lakh as monetary compensation to the NoK of the deceased. In response to the recommendation of the Commission, Dy.Secretary to the Government, Home Department , Govt. of Odisha has submitted a report of ACP, Bhubneshwar-Cuttuck letter dated 26.2.2018 wherein it has been stated that as recommended by the Commission, the compensation amount of Rs.One Lakh by means of a Demand Draft bearing No.296513 dated 28.11.2017 was sent to the father of the deceased Krutibas Mohapatra, however, his father refused to accept the said demand draft in the presence of local people in spite of convincing him to accept the amount. As such the demand draft of Rs.one lakh has been returned to DDO, O/o DG & IG of Police, Cuttuck. Since the father of deceased has refused to accept the compensation amount as recommended by the Commission in spite of convincing him to accept the same by the authority concerned, any further intervention of the Commission is not required in the matter and the case stands closed. The CD of the post mortem, if any available on record be sent back to concerned authority.
