Proof of payment has also been annexed. The Commission has considered the matter. The amount of interim relief, as recommended by the Commission, has been paid to the next of kins of the deceased on 17.5.2013. No further action is called for. These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 27.11.2012. In response, a letter dated 15.1.2013 has been received from Director General of Prisons and Correctional Services, Chenchalguda, Hyderabad. It has been mentioned that regarding grant of interim relief to the legal heirs of the deceased prisoner, it is left to the discretion of the Commission. The Commission has considered the reply. The State Government has no objection to the grant of interim relief to the next of kin of the deceased. An amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) is recommended to be paid as interim relief to the next of kin of the deceased. Chief Secretary, Government of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad is directed to send the proof of payment made to the next of kin of the deceased to the Commission within four weeks.
