<b>Proceeding</b>	<p>The complainant alleged that police of PS Vithalpur, Ahmedabad picked up Sharvan Jhala, Dharmender Jhala, Talubha Jhala, Vipuji Thakur and Mahipat Jhala on the allegation of gambling den on 19.8.2019 and subjected to torture by SI B.S. Chauhan Sharvanjhala received serious injury and was hospitalized. He prayed for action and payment of interim compensation.</p> <p>The Commission transmitted the copy of the complaint to the concerned authorities calling upon report within 4 weeks.</p> <p>In response, SP Ahmendabad Rural Ahmendabad dated 05.02.2020, 18.03.2020. the report reveals that on the investigation it was found that prima facia a case FIR No. 55/2019 has been registered against Police officials S.I, B.S Chauhan, and driver Jigneshbai u/s 323/504/506(2)/114 IPC P.S Viththalapur. Both police officials were arrested on 26.02.2020. Further Charge-sheet has been submitted before J.M.F.C Mandal Court. The trail is pending.</p> <p>The report is taken on record.</p>				

The Commission has considered the report it admitted fact that the police officials/ accused on duty brutally beaten with his belt to the victim, due to which he suffered serious injuries and FIR No. 55/2019 u/s 323/504/506(2)/114 IPC was registered. Thus, the victim's Human Rights were violated by the erring police officials, state is vicariously liable to pay compensation to the victim.

Therefore, the Commission the directs its registry to issue a show-cause notice to the Chief Secretary, Govt. of Gujarat u/s 18 PHRA 1993 as, to show cause as why monetary relief of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh only) should be not recommended to be paid to the victim for violation of human rights.
