Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 06/08/2010, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 03/06/2011. The Commission has made the following directions.

A 26-year-old tribal woman was kidnapped and gangraped by four persons of upper Caste on 31.07.2010 in the jurisdiction of police station Silavd, District Barwani, Madhya Pradesh. FIR no. 110/10 U/S 366/376(g)/ 506 IPC and Section 3 (2) (v) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, was registered against four named accused persons. During the investigation Sections 342/354/509 and 307 IPC and Section (1) (xi) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, and Section 30 of the Arms Act were added to the FIR. All the accused persons were arrested and after completion of the investigation a chargeshoot was filed in the Court.

The Commission wanted to know if the victim had been paid relief under the provisions of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Rules, 1995. The District Collector, Barwani, has informed the Commission vide his letter dated 04.05.2011 that a sum of Rs.50,000/- has been paid as relief to the victim.

The Court being already seized of the matter, the law will take its own course. Relief fund of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, has also been paid. No further intervention of the Commission in the matter is required and the case is closed.
