With reference to your complaint dated 26/05/2011, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 01/11/2012. The Commission has made the following directions.

These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated the 24th September, 2012.

In response to summons, the Deputy Secretary, Home Department, Government of Tripura vide his communication dated the 17th October, 2012 has submitted the compliance report. Perusal of the same reveals that an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) has been paid as interim relief to Md. Anjab Ali, brother of the deceased Lt. Fajar Ali vide cheque No.596208 dated the 10th October, 2012. Proof of payment has also been annexed.

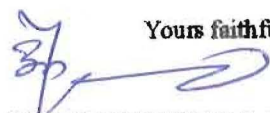
