Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 23/02/2012 and the Commission has directed as follows.

"These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 11.8.2011, when it issued a notice u/s 18(a) (i) of the PHR Act., 1993, to the Government of West Bengal, through its Chief Secretary, to show cause, within four weeks, why suitable monetary compensation should not be recommended to be paid to the victim Giasuddin Mondal.

In response the Joint Secretary, Government of West Bengal, Department of Home(Special) through his communication dated 21.10.2011 has forwarded a copy of memo together with copies of enquiry reports received from the DG & IGP, West Bengal for perusal of the Commission. The enquiry report that has been sent by the DG & IGP, West Bengal has already been considered by the Commission in addition to other material on record and the State of West Bengal has, in fact, not submitted anything new.

Having considered the reports the Commission recommends Government of West Bengal to pay a sum of Rs. 50,000/- as monetary compensation to the victim Giasuddin Mondal. The Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal be asked to send the proof of payment and a report on action taken against errant police personnel.

Response is expected within six weeks."

It is therefore, requested that the compliance report in the matter be sent to the Commission latest by 18/04/2012, so that the same could be placed before the Commission.
