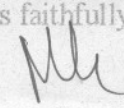
With reference to your complaint dated 09/09/2005, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 05/07/2010. The Commission has made the following directions.

Two Dalits namely, Jaipal and his sister Laxmi of Village Runi, District Farukhabad, Uttar Pradesh, were murdered by Shailendra Thakur and others and FIR No. 381/05 U/S 302/307 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 3(2)(v) of SC/ST Act was registered against the accused persons. After investigation of the case, a chargesheet was filed in the Court. The Commission asked the DM, Farukhabad, to apprise the Commission if compensation under the provisions of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1999, had been paid to the next of kin of the deceased persons.

Now, Shri Hira Lal, Additional District Magistrate, Farukhabad, has informed the Commission vide his communication dated 19.06.2010 that Rs.75,000/- and Rs.1,50,000/- were paid to the next of kin of the two deceased persons through cheques dated 21.09.2005. Copies of the payment receipts are also annexed to the communication. Compensation under the provisions of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1999, having already been paid to the next of kin of the deceased persons, no further intervention of the Commission is required in the matter and the case is closed. It may be mentioned here that all the accused persons have been acquitted by the Court on 18.07.2009.
