directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 11/08/2008 and the Commission has directed as follows.

The Commission recommended to the Govt. of J&K to pay a sum of Rs. Two lakes as monetary relief to the next of kin of Nishu Sharma who was killed in a fake encounter and a further sum of Rs. 50.000/- to Rakesh Sharma who was injured in the same incident. The amount of Rs. Two lakes has been paid to the father of deceased Nishu Sharma and compliance of the recommendation to that extent has been made. However, as regards Rakesh Sharma, the amount of Rs. 25.000/- only has been paid to one Reven Kumar Sharma. The State Government has not explained as why the payment was not made to the injured himself. The relationship between Rakesh Sharma and Revan Lumar Sharma has also not been indicated.

The recommendation made earlier is reiterated. The State Government should pay the entire amount of Rs.50,000/- to the injured himself. Compliance report and proof of payment be submitted to the Commission within six weeks.

It is therefore, requested that the additional/complete report as directed by the Commission in the matter be sent latest by 28/10/2008, for futher consideration by the Commission.
