Sir,

With reference to the above, I have the honour to submit as follows :-

1. That a proposal was received from Deputy Commissioner, Karbi Anglong District for sanction of ex-gratia to next of kins of Parboti Teronpi along with two others who were killed in police firing. However, The, Deputy Commissioner did not enclose the post mortem reports due to which the proposals could not be processed.
2. That the DC Karbi Anglong was requested to submit the post mortem reports.
3. That the DC submitted only one post mortem report out of three cases and intimated that the other two post mortem reports would be submitted as soon as received from the concerned authority.
4. That as DC remained silent for quite some time, he was reminded to expedite submission of post mortem reports.
5. That the DC Karbi Anglong endorsed a copy of report sent to Hon'ble NHRC in connection with case No 190/3/8/08-09/M-I which was received on 16.6.2010. The matter was processed immediately as per procedure and the matter was placed before the competent authority i.e. Hon'ble Chief Minister for favour of approval. The necessary sanctions as per annexure I was issued on 13th September, 2010 as soon as the approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister was received.
6. That regarding the sanction of financial assistance to the injured persons though a proposal was received from DC Karbi Anglong, it did not contain the required documents for which the same had to be returned for resubmission. After receipt of all necessary documents, the matter was processed and the sanction was issued vide annexure II.
7. That as of now the directions of NHRC has been fully complied with and the sanction orders issued in this regard are enclosed at Annexure I and Annexure II.
8. That the undersigned has the highest regard for National Human Rights Commission and its directions and seek unconditional apology for the inconvenience caused to the Commission.

I am directed to convey the sanction of Governor of Assam to an expenditure not exceeding Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakh) only being the ex-gratia grant for payment to Smti Kathie Beypi, Village Phonglokpet, P.O. & P.S. Bakulia, District Karbi Anglong mother and the next of kin of Late Parboti Feronpi who was killed by security personnel on 09-02-2009.

The expenditure is debitable to the head of account "2235-Social Security and Welfare (Other)-11-Other State plan and Non-Plan Scheme-01-Rehabilitation-202-Other Rehabilitation Schemes-93-Relief & Rehabilitation for disturbances rehabilitation Grants-9-Grants in aid General Non-Plan during the current year budget, 2010-2011.

Disbursement is to be made to the next of kin of the killed person after observing all the Rules/formalities/instructions what-so-ever in this regard and subject to availability of fund in the monthly letter of ceiling as may be issued by this Department in due course.. It may also be ensured before disbursement that there is no double payment in any circumstances. The payment is subject to adjustment of fund, paid if any, earlier by the Deputy Commissioner.

The sanction is issued as per specific power delegated to the Deptt. under Sl.12 of Schedule-I of D.F.P. Rules, 1999.
